Recite the following before searching for chametz:

Bedikat Chametz

Recite the following before searching for chametz:



Blessed are You, LORD our God, King of the universe, Who sanctifies us with His commandments and commanded us regarding the removal of chametz.

Note: The ceremonial search for chametz is customarily performed by candlelight on the night *before* the Passover Seder. A feather and a spoon are often used to sweep up the last crumbs of bread, which will then be burned with other chametz the following morning.
