The following blessing is recited over meat, dairy products, and drinks (other than wine) when injested as part of a snack (i.e., other than a full meal). You can recite this blessing when partaking of beverages such as fruit juice, tea, or coffee. In short, it is a general blessing that covers a variety of different food groups:

בָּרוּך אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ כֻֿזֶלֶך הָעוֹלָם, בּוֹרא מיני בשמם

A note about "Kosher Certification"

On packaged foods, one or more of the following symbols tells you that the food has been inspected by one of the many kosher certifying agencies in the United States.



If the word "pareve" appears next to the symbol, this indicates that the product can be eaten with either meat- or dairy-based foods. If the letter 'D' appears next to the symbol, that indicates that the item contains dairy products.
