



# Berachot Megillat Ester

## Traditional Blessings Recited for Purim

**Purim** is considered a minor holiday on the Jewish religious calendar, which means that it is not attended with some of the same halakhic restrictions observed on other holidays. The primary commandment of Purim is to recite three blessings before hearing the scroll of *Esther* (*Megillat Ester*) recited:



ברוך אתה יהוה אלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אָשֶׁר  
קידשנו במצוותיו, וצונו על מקרא מגילה. [ אמן ].

*Blessed art Thou, LORD our God, Master of the universe, who sanctified us with His commandments and commanded us regarding the reading of the Megillah. Amen.*

*Barukh attah Adonai eloheinu melekh ha-olam, asher kideshanu be-mitzvotav, vetzivanu 'al mikra megillah.*



ברוך אתה יהוה אלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, שׁעַטָּה  
נסים לאבותינו בימים ההם, בזeman הזה. [ אמן ].

*Blessed art Thou, LORD our God, Master of the universe, who performed miracles for our fathers in those days at this time. Amen.*

*Barukh attah Adonai eloheinu melekh ha-olam, she-'asah nissim la-avoteinu ba-yamim ha-hem, bazeman ha-zeh.*



ברוך אתה יהוה אלהינו מלך העולם,  
שְׁהַחֲיָנוּ וְקִיְּמָנוּ וְהַנִּצְעָנוּ לִזְמָן הַזֶּה. [ אָמֵן ].

*Blessed art Thou, LORD our God, Master of the universe,  
who has kept us alive and has sustained us, and brought us to this season. Amen.*

*Barukh attah Adonai eloheinu melekh ha-olam,  
shehecheyanu vekiyemanu vehigi'anu lazeman ha-zeh.*

After these blessings are recited, the scroll of Esther (*Megillat Ester*) is read. At the end of the reading, an additional blessing regarding God's vengeance is often recited - and then the oneg begins!

she'a-sah ha'olam me-lekh elo-heynu Adonai at-tah barukh  
Who performed King of the universe our God LORD You Blessed

**נסים לאבותינו בימים ההם, בזמנם הזה. [ אמן ].**

a-mein haz-zeh ba-ze-man ha-hem bayamim la'a-vo-tei-nu nis-sim  
Amen at this time in those days for our fathers miracles

**ברוך אתה יהוה אלהינו מלך העולם,**

ha'olam me-lekh elo-heynu Adonai at-tah barukh  
King of the universe our God LORD You Blessed
