## Blessing upon smelling fragrant spices

שָׁנָן לְמֵאֵר בְּשָׂמִים לְשָׁנָן הַמִּשְׁחָה וְלִקְטֹרֶת הַסַּמִּים

*Oil for the lamps, spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense.  
- Exodus 25:6*

The following blessing is usually recited during the *Havdalah* ceremony to mark one of the distinctions between the sacred and the profane:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם,  
בוֹרֵא מִיְּנֵי בְשָׂמִים.

*Blessed art Thou, LORD our God, King of the  
universe, Creator of different types of spices..*
