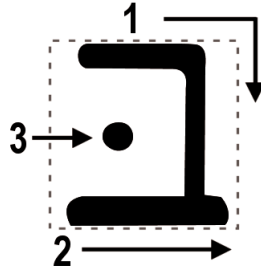


# Bet Writing Practice

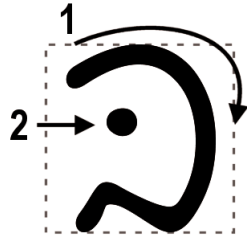
*“b” as in boy*
