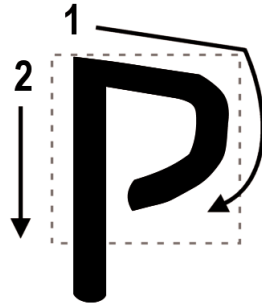

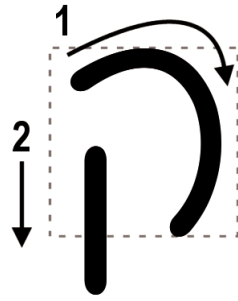
*“Q” as in queen
