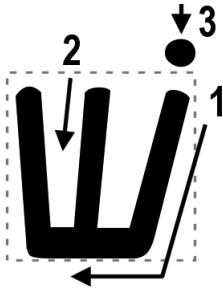


Shin/Sin Writing Practice
