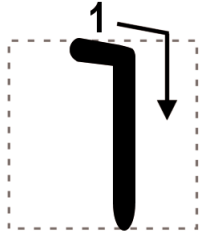


Vav Writing Practice

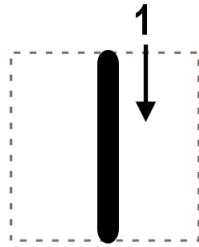
